## Skill Development

- Getting dressed independently, including putting on their own socks and shoes.
- Attempting tricky fastenings such as zips, buttons, buckles and clasps.
- Nursery rhymes and action songs.
- Shared reading, including a range of stories, traditional tales and information books/leaflets.
- Completing the pencil control activity workbook (enclosed) will help to develop pre-writing skills.
- Encourage children to practise writing their name by writing over the dots on their name card (enclosed).
- Colouring activities, encouraging children to stay within the lines applying appropriate pressure.
- Count reliably up to 10 objects.
- Recognise numbers to 10 in their environment, for example, numbers on telephone keypads and clocks.
- Playdough.
- Jigsaws.
- Games such as snap, matching pairs, dominoes, board and dice games.
- Painting activities.
- Making models.
