Skill Development

Literacy:

- Spend time reading stories to your child, especially at bedtime when they are relaxed with no distractions. Talk about the story and its characters.
- Re-tell a story they have listened to in their own words.
- Recognise that some words rhyme.
- Create own rhymes in sentences *e.g. The mouse ran in the house*
- Practise reading words from the High Frequency Word list (enclosed).
- Complete the pencil control activity workbook (enclosed) to help develop fine motor skills.
- Practise writing letter sounds using the alphabet mat (enclosed).

Maths:

- Count forwards and backwards from different starting points up to 10, 20, 30 then beyond.
- Count in 2s up to 20 and 10s up to 100.
- Practise writing numbers regularly using the number mat (enclosed).
- Investigate different ways to make a number, for example, **10 (9+1, 8+2, 7+3 etc.)** then write them down.
- Practise recognising different coins.
