Home Learning Activities

Skill Development

Literacy:

- Spend time reading with your child and ask questions about what has been read.
- Use rhyme to create own verses *e.g. The slimy toad jumped in the road*
- Know the differences between story and information books.
- Practise reading and writing words in the yellow book from the High Frequency Word list (both enclosed).
- Use the purple book (enclosed) to write about things they have done or things they are interested in and draw pictures.
- Discourage the use of random capital letters in their writing.
- Correctly identify all lower and upper case letters and write them independently using the correct letter formation *e.g. aA, bB, cC...*
- Sit letters on the line when writing, ensuring that the tails of letters f, g, j, p, q and y go under the line.

Maths:

- Count forwards and backwards from different starting points using increasingly larger numbers.
- Say what is one more/one less of a number within 100.
- Count in 2s, 5s and 10s as far as they can go.
- Recognise odd and even numbers.
- Practise saying doubles and halves of numbers.
- Practise adding and taking away within 10, then 20, then beyond.
- Make a sensible estimate of objects/items then check by counting.
- Practise adding coins to make different amounts.
